Application for Standard General Consumptive Use Permit For Landscape Irrigation

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO READ BEFORE COMPLETING THIS APPLICATION

This standard general permit application is only for landscape irrigation uses that are below the consumptive use permit thresholds in Rule 40C-2.041, F.A.C. Currently, small-scale landscape irrigation can occur without a water user applying for a consumptive use permit from the District, as long as the irrigation occurs only in the manner authorized in Rule 40C-2.042(2), F.A.C. If a water user intends to irrigate landscape in a manner other than authorized in this rule, the water user must apply for and obtain either a standard general consumptive use permit or, for larger uses, an individual consumptive use permit, authorizing such use.

Important limitation: This form may be used to request authorization to irrigate in any manner other than authorized by Rule 40C-2.042(2), F.A.C., except when the request is to irrigate more than one additional day. When a water user seeks authorization to irrigate more than one additional day than is authorized by this rule, the water user must apply for a Standard General Permit pursuant to 40C-20.042, F.A.C., using form 40C-2-1082-1.

Please note that a healthy landscape typically can be maintained by following the landscape irrigation schedules set forth in the District's rule. The District's rules and information on lawn and landscape irrigation and waterwise landscaping are available on the District's website at floridaswater.com.

Completion of the following application form is required for the permit application to be reviewed. **A permit application fee of \$50 must be submitted with this form.** You can submit the permit application and pay the application fee using the District's website.
